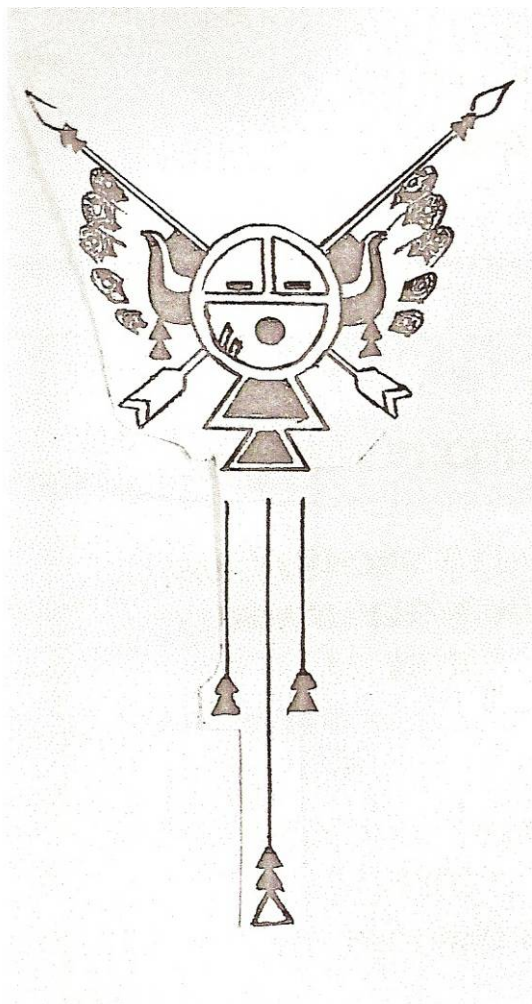


WHAT'S GOING ON
